

Dr. George Adams (1685-1767) of Waltham

1765 June 1 (Saturday). Called at Coll. *Buckminsters*. (N.B. Mr. Bridge who lately met with some Disaster and broke his Collar Bone, is not at home, but is gone to Dr. Adams at Waltham.)

Probably George Adams (1685-1767), described as “a bonesetter” and “chirurgeon.”
