

Barrows

1740 November 10 (Monday). Mr. Matthias Rice bought a Barrow shoat, weight 52.

1747 December 23 (Wednesday). Neighbour Eliezer Rice came with Neighbour Edwards Whipple and they kill'd a Sow which weigh'd 167 and a Barrow which weigh'd 175. They did it gratis.

1757 March 14 (Monday). Neighbour Alpheus Newton brings the 2 Swine I bought of him of the 12th. One a Barrow, the other a sow. Weighed, the former 96, the other 84, so that they come to nine Pound old Tenor.

1758 February 21 (Tuesday). Deacon Tainter came (and was the means of Abner Newtoms coming also) and killed a Barrow for me of 273 lb.

1759 March 3 (Saturday). I bought a Barrow of Neighbour Seth Morse at 15 d. alive -- Weighed 71 lb.
