

Dr. Isaac Bellows (d. 1746) of Marlborough

1727 January 31 (Tuesday). I rode to the South part of Marlborough (call'd Stony Brook) to Dr. Bellus's, to see Mr. Willard, and here was his Kinsman that had been up with me. I tarried here till near night and then rode up to Mr. Brecks.

1727 March 18 (Saturday). It was one o'clock (as I remember) when I set out from Cambridge. I lit upon Mr. Tainter riding up with Hannah Warrin. I rode to Dr. Bellows of Marlborough, Stony Brook, where I stop'd, Mr. Willard being gone up to Westborough. I was not well, or I should have reach'd home, and there was almost Sunrise to have gone by. I went to Bed not very Well.

Dr. Isaac Bellows died Aug. 7, 1746; Southborough Vital Records, 156.

Elisabeth, widow of Dr. Isaac Bellows, died June 6, 1750; Southborough Vital Records, 155.
