

Coffee

1770 September 19 (Wednesday). He accompanied me over to Mr. *Parsons's*. I went there but I could not see him: he was [*illegible*]. Was at the Manufactory. Dined at Mr. *David Hitchcocks*. John was bound to him. Squire [Foster?] and Mr. Moses Hitchcock Witnesses. Squire invited us to go over to his House to drink Coffee with Mrs. Foster.

1774 April 20 (Wednesday). Rode therefore to Mr. *Maccartys*, Mr. *Isaac Pratts*, and thence to *Leicester*. Dined there with *Alexander*. P.M. he went with me to Mr. *Conklins*. Drank Coffee etc. Returned to *Alexanders* and lodged there.

1774 April 28 (Thursday). N.B. Cousen *Davis* dined here, with her Child, her mother Maynard after Lecture and drank Coffee etc. with us.

1774 May 13 (Friday). Mr. *Bradshaw* came from *Boston*, having gone from *New Braintry* to buy Goods (with a Team etc.). My Daughter in Law *Elizabeth* with him. Having dined -- drank [sic] Coffee etc. they Sat out -- fearing a storm.

1774 August 29 (Monday). Capt. *Jonas Brigham* here, and very fierce about our Rulers. N.B. Messrs. *Caleb* and *Levi Wilder* dined here. Miss *Suse* still with us. Mr. *Webb*, Mrs. *Spring* etc. drink Coffee with us.

1774 September 26 (Monday). N.B. A Number of Boys under their Capt. *Moses Warrin*, trained also and behaved agreeably. After Viewing them Mr. Waters and Master [*blank*] *May*, the other school-master, were here, and, with others drank Coffee.

1775 March 15 (Wednesday). Mr. *Bradshaw* came from his Fathers at *Stoughtonham*. Mr. *Fisher Ames* from *Dedham*, and brings, together with a Letter from Mr. *Gordon* of *Roxbury*, his Thanksgiving Discourses, and above 20 Books and Pamphlets. One of which is *Scudder's* daily walk etc. Those young Gentlemen, after drinking Coffee, Set out on their Journey towards *Brookfield* etc.

1775 May 27 (Saturday). Miss *Kezia Adams* p.m. after Coffee returns to *Holliston*.

1775 May 30 (Tuesday). Sat out for *Watertown*, where the *Provincial Congress* is to sit. I had *Jonathan Maynards* Horse. Stopped at Mr. *Stones* and refreshed. Mr. *Leonard* of *Woodstock* and Several others overtook me. I dined at Mr. *Mat. Bridges*. Called at Mr. *Woodwards* -- drank Coffee at Mr. *Jacob Cushings*. I was at Eve greatly perplexed for Lodging. Went to Capt. *Tainters* at *Watertown* where I was kindly welcomed and entertained.

1775 June 22 (Thursday). P.M. Mrs. *Philips*, Wife of Capt. *Philips* of *Boston*, now newly of *Grafton*, and her son and Daughter, called to See Mr. *Shaw*, *Samuel* and *Salley*. They drank Coffee with us.

1775 October 10 (Tuesday). One Miss *Patience Richardson of Lancaster* came to trade with [torn] is at Coffee p.m. as is Master *May*, and both lodge here.

1775 November 21 (Tuesday). P.M. Miss *Eunice Fish* here -- at the Shop and at Coffee. Master Peter Stone was here also.

1775 December 5 (Tuesday). N.B. Mr. *Peter Whitney* and Mrs. Rebecca Warrin had been here and din'd with us. Dr. *Hawes* and Wife and Mr. *Waters* also here at Coffee p.m. The latter consents to preach for me.

1776 January 7 (Sunday). Mr. *May* at Coffee with us at Eve. He prayed and lodges here, as does *Suse*.

1776 January 14 (Sunday). Mr. *May* after Meeting -- at Coffee, at Supper, and prays. He lodges here.

1776 March 21 (Thursday). I drank Coffee at Dr. *Hawes*.

1777 July 4 (Friday). Mr. *Hall (Josiah of Sutton)* came with two of Deacon *Tarrant Putnam's* Daughters, return from *Concord*, and inform that *Hannah* got down to *Samuels* pritty well, and on Thursday undertook to go to *Boston*. They turn out here -- drink Coffee etc.

1778 January 15 (Thursday). The Singing School is so attended, that it causes *Drury Fairbank* to range about for Singing Books.... Mr. *Badcock* came at Eve and drank Coffee here.

1778 February 19 (Thursday). Mrs. *Crosby (Doctors Wife)* made us a Visit -- dined and toward Eve at Coffee, and the Doctor also came. At Eve they leave us.

1778 March 9 (Monday). *Breck* and I rode to Mr. *Grosvenors*, where we dined. Mr. *Willard of Mendon* there also. We proceeded to *Sutton*, to the Paper-Mill. He returned and we drank Coffee there.

1779 February 15 (Monday). *Elias* is so much taken with a pair of Steers at Mr. *Harrington's*, that he prevails with me to go and trade with him for them. I went to his House and drank Coffee with his Mother and Wife.

1779 May 10 (Monday). Mr. *Noah Hardy's* wife here. Mr. *Elijah Brigham* brings his classmate Mr. [blank] *Foot*. They all drink coffee.

1779 May 28 (Friday). P.M. Mr. *William Brigham's* wife, near neighbor to Col. *Brigham* here, drinks Coffee with us etc.

1779 June 10 (Thursday). Mr. *Mellen* and his wife call and drink Coffee.

1780 February 14 (Monday). Breck invites us to Coffee at the Shop and we complied.
