1765 February 19 (Tuesday). Mrs. *Maynard* Sent a Goat Skin for a Pair of Breeches for Elias.

1765 February 20 (Wednesday). Bought a little skin at Mr. Wheelocks for Elias and get Mrs. *Johnson* to make them and because the Goat skin is So large as to be like to be enough for *John*, She is to make him a pair with that.

1776 June 8 (Saturday). [Parkman had gone to Goucester for the installation of his son-in-law, Eli Forbes.] A rich prize taken by Capt. *John Adams* was brought into the Harbour yesterday: a vessel between 4 and 5 hundred Tun -- with much plate, and about 30,000 Dollars, about 400 Casks of Sugar and Rum, a great deal of Mohogany, bags of Ginger, Piemento, livestock (Turtles, Goats etc) bound from *Jemacia* to London. We went on board in the Morning and were treated civily and generously by the Mate, who now had the Care and chief Command.
