

Onions

1738 January 23 (Monday). At Eve Mr. Miles (son of Deacon Miles) from Concord with a present of Onions.

1764 October 20 (Saturday). [Barnstable.] Bid Adieu to my good Friend and Brother *Green* and his. Mr. Williams and I (as requested) dine at Coll. *Otis's*. N.B. His Barn -- Drills -- Onions -- 420 Bush from 135 Rod of Ground -- 90 Bush from 19 Rods. His Wine of Currants -- Cyder -- made better by this method -- viz. Draw it off in March, before the Bud Swells; put in 2 oz. of Pulverized Allum, in a pint of West India Rum -- and break in 2 Cakes of Gingerbread.

1770 December 7 (Friday). William came from *Concord* -- brought my Heiffer, and some onions.
