

Dr. Jeremiah Robinson (c. 1712-1771) of Marlborough

1752 December 25 (Monday). I rode to Mr. Amsdens to Mr. Thaddeus Gale's son Jacob who lies Sick. N.B. Dr. Robinson of Marlborough there. Din'd with him at Mr. Amsdens Table.

1755 March 31 (Monday). N.B. at Eve a great Light as of Some Burning. It appear'd in the North East.

1755 April 1 (Tuesday). News that the Burning last night was Captain Thomas Amsden's House in Marlborough. Suspected to be by his son in Law Dr. Robinson.

1757 December 2 (Friday). Mr. Amsden came for me -- Mr. Smith at Boston -- to go to Marlborough to the Funeral of Dr. Robinsons son Thomas-Amsden, a Boy of about 9 or 10. Returned at Eve.
