1761 May 18 (Monday). I had Mr. Beetons Horse and Visited Mr. Moses Parkers Wife and prayed with the Family. My wife and I dined (by invitation) at Mr. Hills on spare Rib.

1764 December 3 (Monday). Neighbour Prat was so kind as to send me a Load of Wood, and brought a Spare Rib and a Piece of Pork.

1774 January 21 (Friday). I bought a young Store Sow of Mr. *Thaddeus Warrin*, weighed 120 at 17 per pound. Mr. Edwards Whipple here with piece of Beef. Mr. Thomas Bond with Spare Rib.

1777 December 31 (Wednesday). Mr. *Jonathan Child* here -- brings a Spare Rib -- a great Rarity.

1778 January 5 (Monday). Neighbour (now I hear Lieutenant) *Joseph Bond* was here with a large spare Rib.

1779 January 26 (Tuesday). P.M. Deacon Wood. here -- brought a large Spare Rib, advised with him ab't Singing Lecture and he approved of the Steps proposed.

1780 January 17 (Monday). Deacon Wood here with a Spare Rib.

1781 January 29 (Monday). Mr. *Gale* visits me with a spare Rib.

1781 January 31 (Wednesday). Capt. *Maynard* came and brought a Spare Rib, but did not See me.
