1747 October 6 (Tuesday). Just at Evening (I suppose Sundown) I set out on my Journey alone. Reach’d to Captain Lelands, and lodg’d there. N.B. Mr. Isaac Glezon¹ of Framingham there.

1747 October 7 (Wednesday). We were Somewhat disturb’d by a Crew of Indians with a Violin last night while we were o’Bed. But through Divine Mercy I rose well and rode (alone) to Mr. Samuel Brecks in North Sutton.
