1736 February 17 (Tuesday). Windy, Cold Weather -- but the Sun shines upon us. Dennis Clamshire (a Pedlar) here.

1738 December 19 (Tuesday). N.B. One Mr. Daniel Damon of Leicester, who was born near Sydmouth in old England hear with Dears Leather. Bought a skin and a Brass-Albany-Tobacco Box of him.

1757 June 18 (Saturday). One Mr. John *Bish* from Providence here. Sells *Thomme* Sugar and Chocolat.

1760 October 17 (Friday). N.B. an ugly drunken, Swearing, raging Pedler here.

1771 June 11 (Tuesday). Rebuked a Pedlar and turned him off, though Mrs. P. wanted some small Supplys. Hope he will trouble us no more.

1773 January 25 (Monday). Mr. *Nathan Thompson* of *Conventry*, having been to the general Court as one maimed in the Wars, and obtained 60£ Lawful (as he says), is returning home, pedling Rev. *Sampson Occums* Sermons.
