## **Dr. Benjamin Brown (1756-1831)**

1778 July 18 (Saturday). *Elias* went early to *Concord* in his Brothers Chaise, and led Dr. Hawes' Horse to ride back on. He returned p.m. between two and three o'Clock. Dr. *Joslin* and a Young Man named Benjamin Brown (his Tyro, I suppose) with him called and dined here.

1778 October 16 (Friday). P.M. came a Young Man, one *Benjamin Brown* of Lyn, now from *Stoneham*, and expecting to see two of *Timothy's* Sisters, who came at Evening, viz. Miss *Rebecca Cowell*, and Mrs. *Mary Brown*, who also brought her little son *Ezra*, of about 5, who rode in the Chaise with they [sic]. They all lodge here.

1778 October 21 (Wednesday). Young *Benjamin Brown* came from *Sutton* this Morn, and after Breakfast my Kinswomen and their little Boy (Ezra *Brown*) set out for *Stoneham*.
