1738 March 14 (Tuesday). N.B. Lieutenant Holloway brought News from my mother, Brother, etc., with Flower, etc.

1739 February 24 (Saturday). Ensign Maynard brought up a Present from Brother Elias containing a considerable Variety. Scil. Chocolat, Flower, Raisins, Currants, Spices, Limes and Several sorts of Bisketts. Lowery thawing Weather.

1745 June 18 (Tuesday). Mr. Salter brings Sad News from the Fleet and Camp at Cape Briton. Captain Smithhurst missing in the Country Galley, and 140 Land soldiers cutt off in their Attempt on the Island Battery. Yet God has deliver'd 3 French Sail into our Hands, Two 36-Gun-Company-Ships from France and a Quebeck Sloop with Flour and Peas.

1759 December 6 (Thursday). I received a Barrell of Flower from Brother Parkman, which Neighbour Moses Nurse brought up from Brother Samuels.

1760 November 12 (Wednesday). Wrote to my Brother *Parkman* of the Disaster of the Looking-Glass and to desire him to send me another Barrell of Flower.

1764 August 9 (Thursday). Gave Mr. Seth Morse £8.10.9 old Tenor to buy me a Barrell of Flower.

1770 August 24 (Friday). Deacon *Wood* went to Mr. *Samuel Sherman* about Flower for himself and Me.

1770 August 27 (Monday). Brookfield *Elias* goes to Mr. *Samuel Sherman* for Flower. He brings an Hh. for which I am to give 5£ old Tenor of which the Boy carried one Dollar.

1775 April 20 (Thursday). Deacon *Merriam* having been to *Concord* last Eve, returns this morning, and relates that the K's Troops had been there, and did much Mischief -- at the magazine in Special; to Flower, Ordnance, Ammunition, Houses (Several set on Fire), a number on both sides Slain.

1781 March 19 (Monday). Deacon Wood desires me to acquaint the Church after the next Lecture that they must come prepared, next sabbath to contribute for renewing the stock of Elements, Flower and Wine.
