Dr. Josiah Hamilton of Brookfield

1758 December 7 (Thursday). Dr. *Hamilton* here -- dined with us. I can't recommend this place for him to settle in. He goes to Mr. Daniel Forb. I invited him to return and lodge here: which he did.

1758 December 8 (Friday). Dr. Hamilton returned to Brookfield.

According the *Commemorative Historical and Biographical Records of Wood County, Ohio* (Chicago, 1897), 467, in the early eighteenth century, Josiah Hamilton came to Boston from Edinburgh; studied medicine; and settled in West Brookfield.

His son Josiah also became a physician in the same town, and his son, Asa, also studied medicine, starting his practice as early as age 17 or 18. Asa settled in Somers, Connecticut.

Josiah, son of Josiah and Hulda, was b. Feb. 5, 1752 (p. 114) Asa, son of Josiah and Hulda, was b. May 1, 1758 (p. 112)
