Dr. John Hill of Boston

1768 July 11 (Monday). Received a Letter from Dr. Hill of Boston concerning a *stone* which some Brookfield man had carryed him to try it.

1768 July 12 (Tuesday). I walked up the Street to Mr. Zebulon Rice's with a Letter which I received from Dr. *John Hill* of Boston concerning a sort of fossile which tis Supposed by some is the *Cobelt*, found in Brookfield.

1769 December 16 (Saturday). Dr. *John Hill* and Mr. *Joshua Smith* dined here, and prov'd a very great Interruption to me in my Preparations which I could not forward in the former part of the Week.

1768 May 23 (Monday). Mr. Breck and I rode to Boston.... Arrived at Cousen Procters nigh sun sett. Put up the Horse at Mr. *May's*. Lodged at Cousen *Loyds*, with Coll. *Hinckley* of Brunswick. N.B. Dr. *John Hill* lives at Loyds.
