Dr. Jabez Upham (1717-1760) of Brookfield

1755 May 3 (Saturday). Rode to Brookfield. Din'd at Mr. Roberts at Leicester. N.B. Dr. Upham Company from Mr. Eatons. Found my wife and Mr. Forbush and his in Health.

1756 August 20 (Friday). Dr. Crosby came here with Mrs. Upham, Wife of Dr. Upham of Brookfield.

1759 August 29 (Wednesday). Dr. *Gott* rode with me to *Sturbridge*, where I went to see Mr. *Rice*, who is sick. I found him very low indeed. We dined there -- And by reason of their great Importunity I tarryed all Night. N.B. Dr. *Upham* came to see him -- and Dr. *Gott* had his Company to *Brookfield*.
