

Dr. Thomas Williams (1718-1775) of Deerfield

Born in Newton, studied with Dr. Wheat of Boston, moved to Deerfield about 1739.
Received an honorary MA from Yale, 1737.

1746 January 13 (Monday). My Wife somewhat better a.m. (having been sweated the Night before).... At my Return home found my Wife was grown Very ill again, the Fever strong upon her. Mrs. Maynard here and took Suse down to their House, her daughter in law being able to suckle.... And Captain Ephraim Williams junior and his Brother Thomas at Captain Maynards. Sent for the Latter to Visit my wife, who accordingly came. He thinks She is going to have the long Fever.
