1736 March 12 (Friday). Sister *Ruth* very bad indeed -- casting¹ -- Fainting etc. Brother rode to the Doctor. I rode to Town for some New supply.

1736 March 13 (Saturday). Sister in less Pain, and less Casting, more inclined to Doze and Drouze -- otherwise no alteration with her. But although she is detained from her intended Journey [back to Westborough?] and seems to be going to her *long home* -- yet I am necessitated to take my sorrowfull Leave.

1739 November 22 (Thursday). Before I got up I was in great Pains in my Bowels. The Day was a very ill Day with me. I had eat Milk the night before with good appetite, and I thought it sat So well upon my stomach that I might eat boil'd milk this Morning, but I was thereupon greatly disordered. Sick, faint, and Vomited Several Times in the Day Casting up whatever I took down.
